MIKE TUCHEN - RAPID7 PRESIDENT AND CHIEF OPERATING OFFICER

Mike Tuchen joined Rapid7 as President and COO in June 2008 and will lead the company in its next phase of growth as it expands its marketing, sales channels and product development. From 2003 to 2006, he was the General Manager of Microsoft's SQL Server Marketing team, serving his second stint at the company. In that role, he led the SQL product team's worldwide strategic planning and revenue generating efforts, including product marketing, field programs, research and product planning, partner strategy, and pricing/licensing/SKU management. SQL Server is the fastest growing database in the world, and at over \$3.5B is one of the largest businesses in Microsoft.

Prior to rejoining Microsoft in 2003, Mike was General Manager of the Austin, Texas division of Polycom, a \$190mm, 150-person videoconferencing equipment business. Prior to Polycom, Mike co-founded and was Chief Operating Officer of Paramark, a marketing analytics startup. Before Paramark, Mike spent six years at Microsoft in an expanding range of roles, including product marketing, product strategy, and product management. He spent the last two years as Group Program Manager of Exchange Server, driving Microsoft's email strategy, product definition, and product execution for this \$700mm business. Mike began his career at Sun Microsystems, working as an engineer on Sun's SPARC workstations.

Mike holds a Bachelor of Science in Electrical Engineering from Brown University (magna cum laude), a Master of Science in Electrical Engineering from Stanford University, and a Masters of Business Administration from Harvard Business School (Baker Scholar).
