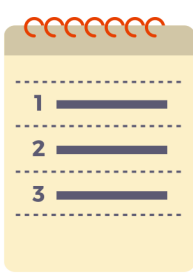
285 vendors

KEY FINDINGS

92% engage in some form of coordinated vulnerability disclosure

NEARLY **80%** of more mature organizations used multiple processes for handling vulnerabilities



FRUSTRATION is the largest driver of public disclosure by practitioners

RESPONSIBILITY to the community and customers drives more mature organizations



60% are concerned about the threat of legal action upon disclosure

76% look internally to develop vulnerability handling procedures



ONLY **15%** expected a bounty but **70%** expected regular communication from vendors

33% expect suppliers to have vulnerability handling practices
